Special Features

Evangel Seminary (ES) holds firm to the evangelical faith, believing steadfastly the divine inspiration of both the Old and New Testaments. The Bible is absolutely infallible and trustworthy, the living word of God and the highest standard of Christian faith and life. We believe our study and ministerial service must be grounded on a stable spiritual life. Spiritual discipline is achieved by combining learning and activities both inside and outside the class, personal and corporate, both in the seminary and the church. The ultimate aim is to build up a living and active spiritual life that supports a multi-facet ministry and equips church workers for today that have both Christ-like character and spiritual leadership. ES also emphasizes practical training that students may know various ministerial structures, planning and that they may put biblical principles into practice.

History of the Seminary

Evangel Seminary is affiliated under the Evangelical Free Church of China and has a long and enduring history. Previously, ES was known as Canton Bible Institute which trained both full time church workers and lay leaders. In 1927, the hearts of Christians were set aflame and they thirsted for God's word during the 1st Canton Bible conference. Evangelical Free Church Evening Bible School (the previous name of Canton Bible Institute) was born to meet this need. Student number rose to such an extent that by 10th Oct of 1932, Canton Bible Institute was founded, to provide full time training to Christians who would dedicate themselves to serve as full time ministers. Owing to changes in political situations, the institute was moved to Hong Kong in 1949. In 1957, by the grace of God, ES moved to the present campus at no. 59 Cumberland Road. In 1965, courses were revised and a new program of Bachelor of Theology began. Simultaneously, our name was changed to Evangel Theological College. In 1992, the program of Master of Divinity was started. In 1996, our English name was changed to Evangel Seminary in order to reflect our aims and academic standard. In 1998, the program of Master of Christian Studies was launched. In 2002, the Master of Theology program started. Through the decades, The Lord has lead godly-men and woman to be presidents of ES, namely, Rev. A.G. Lindquist, Mr. Yan-tak Woo, Rev. Dr. John Pao, Rev. Dr. John Hsu and Dr. Maureen Yeung.

Seminary Alumni

ES now have over Thirteen hundred graduates who serve in Hong Kong, China and various

parts of the world. They serve as pastors, missionaries, Bible translators, theologians, workers in Christian organizations, chaplains in schools, and chaplains in hospitals, tent makers and professionals, to build up the church of God.

Medium of Instructions

ES has always used Cantonese as the main teaching medium. However, students are required to read books, journals and references in both English and Chinese.

Financial Aids

Students who excel in study and spiritual growth may require financial assistance. They can apply for various aids available from ES.

Campus

Our campus is located on a quiet and peaceful site at Cumberland Rd. Kowloon Tong. The Teaching Centre is at no. 59 Cumberland Rd. with President's office, reception, administration offices, classrooms and chapel. The Student Centre is one house away at no. 55, with library and student centre. And the faculty offices and canteen are at 15 Cumberland Rd.

Library

ES library has a collection of over 41,000 books; among them are 4,300 e-books. There are also 150 periodicals, various internet resources, visual aids and reference materials. And we also got a rich resource of Christian education materials that both teachers and students may use and refer to. Our library joins with another four seminaries to form the Ecumenical Information Network (EIN). EIN has an acquisition of more than 300,000 books. Students can borrow books through interlibrary loan service. Our library can sit over 70, equipped with many computers that students can surf the internet.

Looking ahead

ES is facing the tremendous needs of the 21st century. Namely, more Christians are needed to be trained to be pastors, Christian workers, missionaries, church leaders, tent makers and professionals. As we can see there are shortages of pastors and Christians workers in churches and in mission fields all over the world. Besides the quantity of trained pastors, Christian workers and church leaders, quality trainings are eagerly anticipated by the church as well. As higher education has become more accessible in Hong Kong, more quality Church workers and leaders should be trained to meet the pastoral need. ES actively responds to these challenges, we are upgrading all aspects of training full and part time workers to meet the needs of our times.

1. Increase programs, enabling more Christians to come and be trained.

- 2. Revise our syllabus. Increase in proportion and thus strengthen both biblical and theological subjects. So to provide training fits the students for their ministry.
- 3. Increase and recruit faculty members who have both exemplary character and rich pastoral experiences. Thus, students can receive a sound education that emphasizes both theory and practice, learning from and influenced by mature ministerial models.
- 4. Provide and adopt a contemporary and practical training, enabling students to put their knowledge into practice. Thus, they can improve in their ministry and grow spiritually.
- 5. Select prospective students, aiming to train up quality future pastors and church leaders. So that the church can be benefitted ultimately.
- 6. Develop and expand our campus, enabling our students to study in a spacious and well-equipped circumstance.
- 7. Increase books and reference resources, providing a rich acquisition meeting the needs of students in Bible, theology and Christian education studies.
